

# Here are just a few exciting accomplishments from 2022 for the sector and our members.

Launched a new resource for the sector - **Water Sector Cybersecurity Case Studies**. This new resource is made up of anonymous experiences that can assist all water and wastewater utilities learn from others' difficult situations and improve their cybersecurity.

Produced **Quarterly Water Sector Incident Summaries** that included 149 shared incidents of water and wastewater cyber attacks and physical incidents. These quarterly reports provide information and awareness of the ongoing threat environment for our members.

Conducted a cybersecurity survey for US Water and Wastewater Utilities to **expand our portfolio of resources** and support our members.

Instituted **WaterISAC's Champion program** for leaders in the sector to provide ongoing benefits and knowledge to members.
